



## FAQ



### **Is there an age restriction?**

Yes. Volunteers must be 16 years of age or older. (Volunteers 16 & 17 must have Volunteer Waiver form signed by parent/guardian before working onsite.)

### **Are refreshments provided?**

Yes. Water, coffee, snacks and lunch are provided. If you have any dietary restrictions, please bring some of your own food to ensure you have enough for the day.

### **Where should I park?**

Parking is at the Concordia Club, about a 5 minute walk from the Kehl build site. Please refer to your confirmation or reminder email for the link with the parking pass and details.

### **What should I bring?**

Refillable water bottle and sunscreen. A bandana for under your hard hat is a good idea too.

### **What about tools and safety equipment?**

We have all the tools you'll need and safety equipment too.

**IMPORTANT:** Green-patch CSA safety boots are required on the site along with Class E, Type II hard hats. We have a selection on site for you to borrow if you do not have your own.

### **How should I prepare for my build day?**

Come rested and ready to work. Wear layers of clothing appropriate for the weather. Shorts are discouraged. Pants provide coverage and protection for your legs on a busy construction site. Wear socks for your work boots.

### **Are there tasks for all skill levels and ability?**

Yes. There is a task for everyone on a Habitat build site regardless of experience or ability. (Please note, the ability to walk up and down stairs is a requirement for almost all areas of the build site.)



## FAQ

### **Is First Aid available?**

Yes. First Aid kits are always available at Habitat build sites.

### **What about valuables?**

We do not accept responsibility for valuables on site.

### **Are there washroom facilities?**

Yes. We have a port-o-potty on the construction site and flush toilets in the hospitality area.

### **May I come late?**

No. Morning Orientation happens once a day starting at 8:30am. This is a requirement to be on site. If you miss this, you miss the chance to build that day.

### **Do we build in the rain?**

We build in most weather conditions. Please come dressed in layers prepared to work indoors or outdoors. In the rare cases we close the site, we will notify you by email by 6:30am.

### **How do I prepare for a winter build?**

Come dressed in layers to work indoors or outdoors, or inside in a potentially unheated environment. Bring gloves and a light toque (no pom-pom) to fit under your hard hat.
